- identify options that homeowners may be able to access to become or stay current.
- provide information on the foreclosure process.
- assist in developing a household spending plan.
- negotiate on a homeowner's behalf with a lender or servicer for repayment strategies.

And we can offer these tips to homeowners facing foreclosure:

- Act now. The sooner you get assistance, the more options you have.
- Be wary of anyone offering a quick fix, such as buying your home and then selling it back to you.
- Most importantly, focus on making your house payment first, above everything other than life necessities.
- Make sure you know what the foreclosure process means and what rights you have. The process is different from state to state, and your lender may be unaware of important information. For example, in Minnesota you *do* get to stay in your home after a Sheriff's sale has taken place.
